

Executive Summary All Saints' Asset-Mapping Report

In December 2023, All Saints' collaborated with Partners for Sacred Places to orchestrate a Community Asset-Mapping event to explore opportunities for optimizing facility usage, engaging with the community, and expanding our network of supporters. Key objectives included:

- Conducting an inventory of All Saints' assets
- Identifying potential partnerships by understanding community needs
- Brainstorming ways to align assets and community needs

Several significant themes emerged from this collaborative effort:

1. Growing our relationship with UT and Students

- a. Extending/growing counseling services
- b. Providing meeting spaces, especially for religious and social groups
- c. Supporting diversity initiatives not currently feasible under university regulations (SB17)

2. Expanding social services

- a. Providing nurses for housing insecure and low-income communities
- b. Offering kitchen facilities for various purposes
- c. Hosting "pop-ups" for additional services during events like Loaves & Fishes

3. Support for Caregivers and Parents

- a. Introducing adult senior day-out programs
- b. Strengthening aligned efforts with caregiver support

4. Promoting Arts and Culture

- a. Making available/creating meeting and rehearsal spaces
- b. Offering performance venues
- c. Developing partnerships with amateur groups (example: Texas Jugglers' Assoc.)
- d. Establishing visual galleries, as previously in Kinsolving / Chapel of HS

Meeting these aspirations entails addressing challenges and necessitates further actions:

1. Build and Clear rooms to use as shared space

- a. Potential impact on All Saints' staff and Day School
- b. Enhanced volunteer coordination to mitigate staff impact
- c. Consideration of potential constraints on planning internal activities, such as those in the Masterson Library
- d. Integrating requirements for these initiatives into facility upgrade plans
- e. Physical updates to make facilities accessible/ADA compliant

Immediate actions – how does this affect us?

- Evaluate ideas for quick wins with high enthusiasm and low workload.
- Strategize on long-term initiatives, identifying a roadmap for execution.
